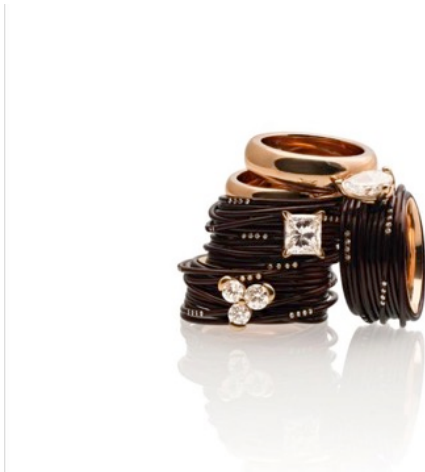

On this morning you will have a private guided tour at [Seaplane Harbor Museum](#) or [KUMU ART MUSEUM](#) in Kadriorg.

The Seaplane Harbor is one of the most exciting museums in the region, as its hangars are architecturally unique in the whole world. The complex was initially completed as part of Peter the Great's Naval Fortress in 1916 - 1917. The new museum combines both past and present. This newly opened exhibition in the historical seaplane hangars tells you stories from under the water, on the water and over the water.

KUMU Art Museum was opened in 2006. This is the new and grand headquarters of the Art Museum of Estonia, which attracts everyone that is interested in Estonian art and culture. Both Estonian art classics as well as the works of artists that cultivate modern trends are on display at Estonia's largest museum. In 2008, the KUMU Art Museum was recognized as the best museum in Europe and the winner of the European Museum of the Year Award. The European Museum Forum, the activities of which are supported by European Commission, presents the Award.
